## Jan. 17—Puppet Workshop

Learn about and watch examples of several types of puppetry, practice puppetry techniques, then create different styles of puppets yourself, including sock and shadow puppets.

## Feb. 21—Blue Horses: Using Color in Unusual Ways

Learn about artist Franz Marc and other artists who have used color in unexpected ways and enjoy a book about this topic by author/illustrator Eric Carle. Then make your own “crazy color” picture using markers, oil pastels, or crayons.



## Mar. 20—Weaving Workshop

Learn about the art of weaving, look at real examples of woven textiles from around the world, then create your own cardboard loom and begin your own weaving project using yarn and other materials.

## Apr. 17—Working with Wood

Look at different pieces of artwork that incorporate wood, learn some basic woodworking techniques (sanding, gluing, hammering), and then create your own sculpture using scrap wood and paint.



## May 15—Watercolor Workshop

Look at a variety of watercolor paintings, then have fun experimenting with several watercolor techniques including masking, “wet on wet” painting, and using salt with watercolors.
